





- 3. Cover page, table of contents, certificate, acknowledgements, introduction, conclusion, bibliography, headings and sub headings are a must.
- 4. Each section should be done on white/coloured A4 size sheets.
- 5. The project should be presented in cobra file with beautiful handmade cover.
- 6. The project should not exceed 15-20 pages.

[Do any one project on the following topics]

Project 1: Conservation of Natural Resources

- Collect information on Bioreserves, National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries focusing on the policy of conservation of endangered species.
- Locate Bioreserves, National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries of following states.
 (Jharkhand, Bihar, Assam, Uttarakhand and Madhya Pradesh.) (Draw separate map of state and locate and label)
- Write about Forest fire, reasons and solutions.
- Collect pictures, travel writings, photographs and brochures to describe the special characteristics of these natural reserves.

Project 2: Natural Vegetation and wildlife

- Collect information about Natural Vegetation and wildlife.
- Explain in detail about types of Natural Vegetation.
- Use Physical map of India to locate types of Natural Vegetation in India.
- Write about the Wildlife Protection Act.
- Locate National Park and Wildlife sanctuary of state Jharkhand, Bihar, Assam,
 Uttarakhand and Madhya Pradesh. (Draw separate map of state and locate and label)

Project 3: Disaster Management

Explain in details about the meaning of disaster management.

- Explain the Types of Disasters, Causes, Consequences and how to save ourself during these disasters.
 - o Natural Disasters: Earthquakes, floods, tsunamis, cyclones, droughts.
 - Man-Made Disasters: Industrial accidents, chemical spills, nuclear disasters, terrorism, etc.
- Disaster Management Plan
 - Risk Assessment: Identifying potential risks and the vulnerabilities of the area/community.
 - o Preparedness Plan
 - Early Warning Systems: Using technology and communication systems to warn people about impending disasters.
 - Evacuation Routes and Safe Zones: Identifying safe shelters and routes.
 - Resource Management: Storing emergency kits, food, water, medicines, and tools.
 - Training & Drills: Conducting regular disaster preparedness drills in schools, offices, and communities.
 - o Emergency Response:
 - First responders' roles: Medical teams, firefighters, police, NGOs, volunteers, etc.
- Role of national agencies (e.g., NDMA National Disaster Management Authority in India.)
- Analyse a recent disaster (e.g., In 2024, floods in Vijayawada caused widespread damage and loss of life, COVID-19 pandemic.)

Project should be developed in the following sequence.

- 1. Cover page showing title, student information (Name, Class & Roll No) School & Academic Year.
- 2. Certificates, Acknowledgment & Preface.
- 3. List of Contents/Index.
- 4. Introduction
- 5. Chapters with suitable headings. (Supported with pictures.)
- 6. Conclusion. (Summary, Benefits/Importance of the task).
- 7. Bibliography.
- 8. Appendix (If any).


Write a diary entry as a member of the Third Estate, describing your feelings and expectations after the storming of the Bastille.
