Aims And Objectives

The curriculum developed for class UKG aims at helping the child unfold his/her talents, to facilitate and guide the child to sharpen his mental and physical abilities. It helps to enhance the learning, speaking, writing and listening skills of the child.

The Programme is based on a child-centered approach wherein through play-way the basic concepts are taught. The main emphasis is placed on the child's experiences and interaction.


A typical day in class UKG starts with the morning prayer followed by a 15-minute free / general conversation session during which the children will get an opportunity to share their experiences at home and outside the school. During this time, major news items at national level as well as the school and family-related issues will be discussed.

At the end of each day, 15 minutes will be devoted to rhyme and story-telling sessions. A general conversation based on the topic of the month is also done. The general conversation also includes moral education, vocabulary building and other relevant topics.

The UKG syllabus thus aims at an all-round personality development to guide the child to develop himself as a better human being.


